Important updates in Lexis Red 3.20

Overview

- Show the full document path for publications in 'Recent History'
- Include publisher pages in the PDF export – books only

Show the full document path for publications in 'Recent History'

Problem statement: As a Red user, I want to quickly access previously viewed documents from Recent History, but I cannot always see the relevant TOC and document info to enable me to choose the right document.

Solution: The full path of a recently viewed document is now shown under Recent History, including all TOC levels and the document name.

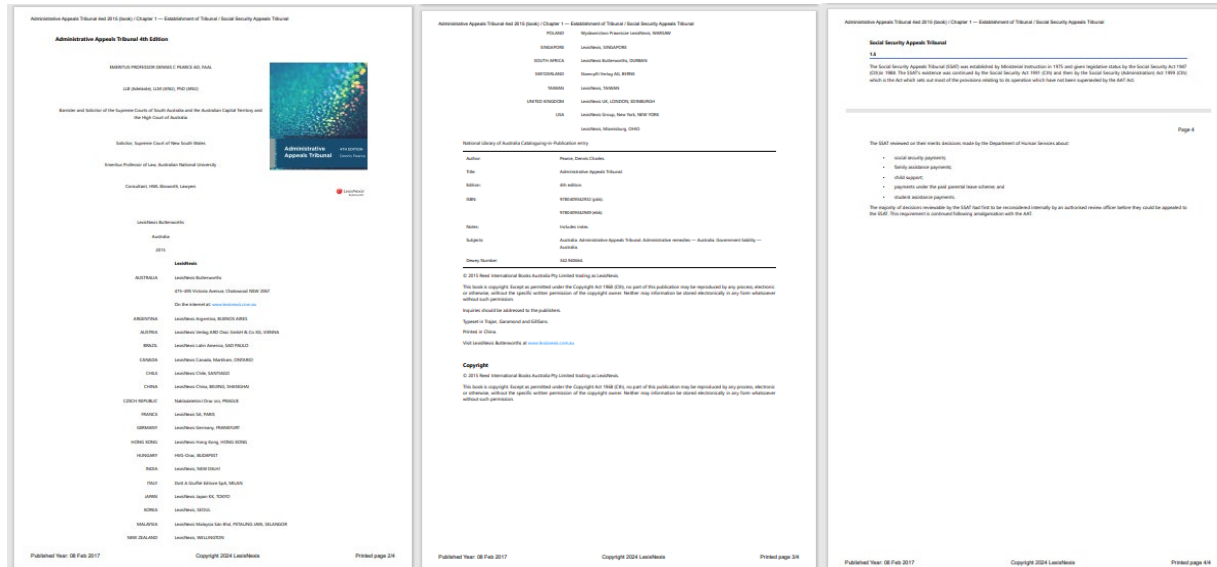
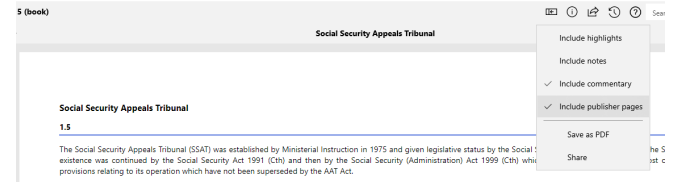

Include publisher pages in the PDF export – books only

Problem statement: As a Red user, I want content I export from Red to be easily identified with the book and edition from which it is extracted such that it is easily matched to the print version so that my citations are trusted.

Solution: The user can choose to include publisher pages with their PDF extract of Red book content.
